Please be advised of the following:

Water stoppages

Due to water stoppages beyond our control, we ask you to please supply your children with sufficient juice/bottles of water to see them through the day. The school will always provide buckets from the swimming pool to flush toilets and wash hands, but we unfortunately cannot rely on the Municipal Water Department to provide water tankers. Thank you for your support.

Lice

With the extreme temperatures we have been experiencing lately we have seen the reoccurrence of lice and we ask all parents to please check their children's hair and take appropriate actions if necessary. To avoid an infestation we cannot allow children back without a clearance certificate.



Swim-a-thon

This will be our chief fundraising event this term and monies raised will be used to purchase new starting blocks. We are asking children to find as many sponsors as possible who may either give a donation or alternatively sponsor learners per length. Kicker boards may be used for those children requiring assistance, and we would like to see as many learners as possible involved in getting across the length of the pool.
